#### Q. BOARD SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

**1.** Budget (Budd, Casado, Hovsepian)

During the Budget Board Subcommittee meeting on August 22, members discussed the minimum wage consultant request for proposal on the Board's August 30 Action agenda. A committee of representatives from Faculty Senate, CSEA, CUBSS, Payroll, Human Resources and Business Services interviewed consultants and unanimously recommended RSG Inc. as the consulting firm that would best be suited to study and analyze Clovis Unified salary schedules and position descriptions impacted by California's upcoming minimum wage increases. Also discussed was the successful rollout of new Xerox machines at all District school sites, District services buildings and in the Graphic Arts Department. Members learned that the Permission Click online program, which was piloted in the District on a small scale last spring, is now being used District-wide and is receiving positive feedback. The program enables parents to conveniently grant permission electronically for their students to attend fieldtrips, participate in curriculum, etc. Also shared was a Campus Catering bread-sales fundraiser opportunity for schools that would enable more of the raised money to go to the sites. Finally, the re-funding of District bonds was reviewed.

2. Center for Advanced Research and Technology (CART) (Sandoval)

The CART Board of Directors did not meet.

3. Curriculum (Budd, Hovsepian, Van Volkinburg)

At the August 22 meeting of the Curriculum Board Subcommittee, members reviewed Clovis Unified's preliminary student achievement data, not yet officially released due to a State of California embargo. (Recent communication from the California Department of Education indicates the embargo will be lifted the week of September 18, 2017.) A Board workshop will be held in the future regarding District students' testing results from 2016-17. Members were also given a list of textbooks and workbooks that are now obsolete. Members of the Board will be asked to approve the disposal of these materials at their September 13 meeting. Finally, summer school was discussed. A "Newcomers Summer School" program was introduced this year for elementary through high school students who are brand-new to the country. The innovative program successfully met the educational needs of 85 students. In total, 7,200 students attended summer school this year.

**4.** Facilities (Fogg, Heryford, Sandoval)

Members of the Facilities Board Subcommittee discussed current bond measure projects at their August 18 meeting. Members reviewed the change order, bond measure finance, and design, bid, and construction reports. Possible southeast area elementary school site locations were discussed. Finally, a Facilities Department staffing update was given.

## RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Provisional Internship Permits for three recommended teaching candidates, as submitted.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) is available when the employing agency knows that there will be a teacher vacancy, yet is unable to recruit a suitable candidate. The expectations of the employer and the employee are higher since these individuals will be the teacher of record and should be on a credential track. The focus of the document is meeting subject matter competency. Once a candidate completes subject matter competency, the candidate can be employed on a document such as a District Internship Credential. Candidate requirements include the following: (1) Bachelor's degree or higher; (2) passage of the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST); and (3) specific course work or experience, explained in detail on the Provisional Internship Permit Information leaflet.

As required by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC), employing agencies offering employment to candidates on a Provisional Internship Permit are required to: (1) conduct a diligent search for a suitable credentialed teacher or qualified internship teacher; (2) provide the PIP holder with orientation, guidance, and assistance as specified in Title 5 Section 80026.5; (3) assist the PIP holder in developing a personalized plan (kept on file at the local level) through an agency-defined assessment leading to completion of subject matter competence; and (4) counsel the PIP holder to enroll in subject matter training. Clovis Unified School District Administration hereby declares that a diligent search was conducted for suitable credentialed teachers or qualified internship teachers. Upon Board approval, District Administration asserts that steps 2-4, as outlined above, will be completed.

School districts submitting Provisional Internship Permit requests must include verification that a notice of intent to employ the applicants in the identified positions was made public. The public notice must include the following information: (1) the name of the applicants; (2) the assignment in which the applicants will be employed including subject(s), grade level(s), and school site; and (3) a statement that the applicants will be employed on the basis of a Provisional Internship Permit. Clovis Unified School District intends to submit Provisional Internship Permit requests for the following teacher candidates, contingent upon administration and Board approval:

The permit request must include a signed statement from the Superintendent, or designee, that the item was acted upon favorably. ## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution No. 3609 establishing the recalculation of the 2016-17 Gann Limit Appropriation and estimating the 2017-18 Gann Limit Appropriation.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The Gann Limit (named for Paul Gann, the author of Proposition 4 which amended the State Constitution to establish this limit) is intended to constrain the growth in State and local government spending by linking year-to-year changes in expenditures to changes in inflation (represented by per capita personal income) and population (represented by average daily attendance (ADA) for schools). Established in 1979 following the enactment of Proposition 13 and subsequently amended by Proposition 111, the Gann Limit has become a largely pro forma calculation that no longer constrains governmental expenditures. This is because the limit has grown significantly faster than appropriations subject to the limit.

Education Code Section 42132 requires that on or before September 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, the Governing Board adopt a resolution to identify the estimated appropriations limit for the current fiscal year and the actual appropriations limit for the preceding fiscal year.

Clovis Unified is required to perform Gann Limit calculations by the State Constitution, but it is also important for the District to complete these calculations to identify how much State aid counts toward its Gann Limit, so that the State of California knows how much State aid counts toward its own Gann Limit.

The attached worksheet reflects the recalculated 2016-17 Gann Limit Appropriation for the District, which is \$258,352,348, and the estimated Gann Limit Appropriation for 2017-18, which is \$277,234,825. This worksheet will also be reviewed by members of the Budget Board Subcommittee during their September 12, 2017, meeting.

## RESOLUTION TO RECALCULATE THE 2016-17 GANN LIMIT APPROPRIATION AND ESTIMATE THE 2017-18 GANN LIMIT APPROPRIATION

**WHEREAS**, in November of 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIII-B to the California Constitution; and,

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of that Article establish maximum appropriation limitations, commonly called "Gann Limits," for public agencies, including school districts; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Clovis Unified School District must establish a revised Gann Limit for the 2016-17 fiscal year and a projected Gann Limit for the 2017-18 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Article XIII-B and applicable statutory law; and,
